What's included with APS (Alexander Patrol Services) when you pay your annual HOA dues?

HOA update

We have increased the security presence in the neighborhood and are now paying for 2 patrol cars.

Homeowners are entitled to a 7 day annual vacation watch. APS will pull in trash cans if they are on the curb. They will pick up flyers, door knob ads, and packages left on the porch. They will not receive a delivery for a homeowner. If access is open to a backyard (no fences/gates), they will go around the side yard to check on the property.

If a homeowner is present at the home, they can call APS for suspicious activity.

A homeowner can receive 2 escorts per month (for example if arriving home late and concerned for their safety).

A homeowner cannot give their alarm company APS' number to appear because they don't have a formal agreement to serve that purpose. Cheviot Hills Homeowners' Association is a voluntary organization of residents who work together to improve and maintain the quality of life in our neighborhood. We address community concerns as a means of enhancing a sense of community. We work collaboratively with our local government agencies to facilitate the need for a rapid response from local agencies and residents to resolve community concerns.

The Cheviot Hills HOA has increased its annual membership dues (from \$70 to \$95) to strengthen our HOA-funded private security patrol. Over sixty percent of the HOA's budget already goes towards this neighborhood-wide private security. In anticipation of the additional pooled HOAmember resources, the HOA Board has increased the number of hours per day that the private security patrols Cheviot Hills.
